KELSO LOCATION

KELSO CONSERVATION AREA, MILTON, ON

A favorite among PK campers, Kelso Conservation Area is a beautiful 980 – Acre Park located in Milton, and part of the majestic Niagara Escarpment. With its spectacular views, thousands of trees, lifeguarded sandy beaches for swimming, open air shelters, boating, trails, caves, and other amenities, including Country Heritage Park, the Kelso location is ideal for those who prefer to be in a traditional outdoor camp setting, while also having everything they need for an exciting variety of fun camp activities. Bussing is provided to Kelso from 42 locations. Please see the Kelso Bus Schedule for further details.

Extended Care Cost: AM \$25/fam/wk PM \$25/fam/wk

Sleepover Option: Available for children who have completed grade 1 - 6 & registered in our Kelso Traditional, Multi-Sport or Nature Explorers camps. The one-night sleepover option is a popular event, giving campers the opportunity of experiencing overnight camping fun in a familiar, safe environment. Participants will enjoy organized games & activities, including a traditional camp fire and marshmallow roast. Tents are provided, as well as Wednesdays dinner, breakfast and lunch for Thursday.

Cost: \$45/child/week + HST

SWIMMING AT KELSO

Swimming at our Milton location; Kelso Conservation Area takes place daily for ALL groups. Swimming is done on site at Kelso Beach. Planet Kids, YMCA and Ways of the Woods share a section of the beach divided between the 3 camps and separate from the public side. While camps are at the beach public are not able to swim in our section.

Lifeguards are provided, to us. One life guard is sitting in the life guard chair the other standing on the beach. Staff are in the water with campers as well.

Life jackets are provided to ALL campers who are required to wear one. Planet Kids recommends that campers under the age of 7 at our Milton location, wear a life jacket. Please see the life jacket policy for our Oakville locations under Swimming at Kings and St. Mildreds-Lightbourn School.

Campers will swim daily for 45 minutes to an hour. Swimming is a recreational swim only, lessons are not given. Campers not wanting to swim can take part in other activities being run at the beach by the staff who are not swimming.

PLEASE NOTE: In the event that swimming cannot be done, due to low water levels or a beach closure, other types of water activities will be put in place for campers. Unfortunately a beach closure & low water levels are out of Planet Kids control. If we are made aware of a possible beach closure or low water levels ahead of time, we will be sure to inform all customers, via email and by posting to our social media pages.

KINGS LOCATION

Kings Christian Collegiate OAKVILLE, ON

King's Christian Collegiate is a private high school facility in Oakville, nestled in a picturesque area at Burnhamthorpe Rd & Neyagawa Blvd, just north of Dundas St, and south of the 407, close to several growing communities. Built in 2001, with a new wing added in 2007, King's is an 80,000 square foot state of the art facility including a large, air conditioned double gymnasium, stage, open 2-storey atrium,, cafeteria seating, as well as a full size outdoor soccer/ football field, pond, trails and more. Swimming will be enjoyed twice a week at a nearby pool. Bussing is provided from a few stops in Oakville, Mississauga Milton, & Burlington.

SWIMMING AT KINGS

Swimming for our Oakville location at King's Collegiate takes place offsite at David Ramsey outdoor pool in Mississauga. This is a private booking with no public access during our swim times. All camp groups will swim twice per week on Tuesdays and Thursdays, for 1 hour. Transportation to and from the pool is provided by school bus. Planet Kids Staff are in the water with their campers at all times. 3 or 4 lifeguards are provided by the municipal pool to help ensure the safety of all campers.

Please note: That in order for Planet Kids to stay within the requirements, set by the Municipal Pools, any camper 9 and under will be required to wear a lifejacket, regardless if parent consent is given. Lifejackets are provided by Planet Kids.

TRANSPORTATION

We provide busing at no additional cost. For our Kings location we have bus stops in the following cities; Burlington, Oakville, Milton and Mississauga.

In order to guarantee your child's spot on the bus registration for busing is required, if you have multiple children each child needs to be registered. If you have registered and forgot to add busing, please contact our office and we can make the updates for you, pending availability of the bus stop you require.

Families are only able to register for ONE bus stop, we do not allow campers to switch between stops. We do not allow campers to only use the bus one way to camp, if they are registered for the bus, it is expected and required for them to take the bus both ways. We have these rules in place to ensure that each child is being properly accounted for each day as well as to save any confusion as to where the child(ren) should be going at night/in morning.

SWIMMING AT SMLS

Swimming for our Oakville location at St. Mildred's-Lightbourn School takes place offsite at David Ramsey outdoor pool in Mississauga. This is a private booking with no public access during our swim times. All camp groups will swim once per week on Wednesdays, for 1 hour. Transportation to and from the pool is provided by school bus. Planet Kids Staff are in the water with their campers at all times. 3 or 4 lifeguards are provided by the municipal pool to help ensure the safety of all campers.

Please note: That in order for Planet Kids to stay within the requirements, set by the Municipal Pools, any camper 9 and under will be required to wear a lifejacket, regardless if parent consent is given. Lifejackets are provided by Planet Kids.

TRANSPORTATION

We provide busing at no additional cost. For our St. Mildred's-Lightbourn School location we have bus stops in the following cities; Burlington, Oakville, and Mississauga.

In order to guarantee your child's spot on the bus registration for busing is required, if you have multiple children each child needs to be registered. If you have registered and forgot to add busing, please contact our office and we can make the updates for you, pending availability of the bus stop you require.

Families are only able to register for ONE bus stop, we do not allow campers to switch between stops. We do not allow campers to only use the bus one way to camp, if they are registered for the bus, it is expected and required for them to take the bus both ways. We have these rules in place to ensure that each child is being properly accounted for each day as well as to save any confusion as to where the child(ren) should be going at night/in morning.

LEADERSHIP CAMPS

Our progressive leadership program has two levels, each offering youth an exciting opportunity to develop important 'life skills' through fun, interactive and challenging activities. Upon completion of the leadership programs, participants are encouraged to enroll in our Counsellor- In-Training program.

Leadership Zone - \$235/wk + HST Completed Gr 7&8

Leadership Zone is a one week camp and gives youth an excellent opportunity to develop their self-confidence and self-esteem and learn skills they can apply in school, at home, and with peers. Through a variety of interactive activities, specialized games and challenges, campers will learn effective team building skills, communication skills, organizational skills and problem solving skills.

Leadership Exploration and Development \$540/2wk session + HST Completed Grade 8-11

Formerly Leadership Extreme our Leadership Exploration and Development (LEAD) is a two-week program geared to campers who, in the future are wanting to become a counsellor. Throughout the two weeks campers will gain valuable experience, skills and discipline to help them become effective camp counsellors in the future. They will focus on; leadership building activities, effective communication, problem solving, skill building activities such as archery, boating and hiking, camper characteristics and more. Campers will be assigned to help out with various camp duties, such as helping run the end of the week Major Special, bus buddies, and even being a counsellor for a half day. In addition, participants will enjoy a one-night sleepover event, aimed at further developing their team-building skills. Campers will also enjoy an offsite trip to an Escape Room, which will see them using problem solving skills, team work and communication with one another.

Important: This program is a prerequisite for our Counsellor In Training program. Upon successful completion of LEAD campers are welcome to participate in our CIT program, an exclusive camp volunteer opportunity. Please note to register for our Leadership Exploration and Development program, participants must be finished grade 9, 10 or 11. Those finished Grade 8 may also register if they have first completed our Leadership Zone program.

COUNSELLOR IN TRAINING

Our CIT program is a great volunteer opportunity available exclusively for those who have first successfully completed our Leadership Exploration and Development (LEAD) program. CITs are assigned to a camp group for the week, assisting the staff with various camp duties, activities and special events. This will help further develop and implement good leadership skills while also teaching about working with children effectively. CIT's will be provided with 2 CIT shirts they are to wear each day while at camp. A CIT certificate will be provided to each CIT acknowledging their volunteer hours, which may be applied towards their high school requirement (guidelines vary - check with your high school). Each full week of CIT = 40 volunteer hours. CITs may be eligible for future employment with Planet Kids. This is BY INVITATION, based on performance and our staffing needs. Employment is not guaranteed. To register for our CIT program please call our office at 289-291-0870. CIT registrations must be made by phone and are limited to two weeks per camp location.

FAQ'S

General Questions

Can my child take medication while at camp?

If your child requires medication of any kind while at camp, you must sign a Medication Release & Permission to Administer Form giving permission for our staff to administer the medicine to your child.

Can I pick up my child early from camp?

It is preferred that campers ARE NOT picked up early from camp. This causes a great deal of extra time and planning, and interrupts the daily camp routine for your child, other campers and staff.

If however you are need to pick your child up early please fill out a Note to Camp which you may get from the Bus Monitor at the bus stop or Camp director at the camp location.

How many children are in each group?

Our camp groups vary in size depending on age level, type of camp and activities. A typical camp group consists of 16-24 children with two qualified staff.

What if I am unable to pick up my child & wish to send someone else in my place?

Campers should be picked up by one of their parents however when this is not possible a written note must be sent to camp naming the alternate care giver and giving them permission for them to pick up your child(ren). If a situation arises at the last minute, you MUST call our Administrative office.

What happens if I am late to pick up my child?

For late arrivals, a Late Fee of \$5.00 for every 5 minutes will apply. If you are late, you can be assured that your child will not be left unattended.

My child would like to be placed in the same group as a friend/sibling, but they have completed different grades, is this possible?

Placing children in the same group is possible. There are a couple of factors we take into consideration, such as the camp group you're wanting to place them in together. If there will be a significant age difference between your child and the other children in the group, we cannot make an exception. Please contact our office before registering and we would be happy to see what we can do.

FAQ'S

Transportation

Is transportation provided?

Transportation is provided at no additional cost to each of our locations. We offer number of pick-up locations to choose from. Please see each locations Bus Guides for stop locations.

PLEASE NOTE: To guarantee a spot on the bus, for your child(ren) registration is required, before camp begins.

Are the children supervised on the bus?

YES! We have Bus Monitors at almost all of our stops. Bus Monitors are Planet Kids staff scheduled to supervise children at the bus location and on the bus to/from camp.

What cities do you offer busing from?

For our Milton location at Kelso Conservation we offer busing from the following cities: Acton, Burlington, Cambridge, Campbellville, Carsisle, Georgetown, Guelph, Milton, Mississauga, Oakville, and Waterdown.

For our Oakville location at Kings Christian Collegiate we offer busing from the following cities: Burlington, Milton, Mississauga & Oakville.

For our Oakville location at St. Mildre's-Lightbourn School we offer busing from the following cities; Burlington, Oakville and Mississauga.

Can I to drive my child to camp on Monday, instead of taking the bus?

If you choose to drive your child(ren) to camp on Monday morning instead of taking the bus, they will not be able to ride the bus home from camp, that night.

Monday mornings are very important for all campers; they receive a bus tag, are informed of their bus number, are introduced to the staff on the bus and are made aware of what stop they are too get off at. They would be missing all of this important information, to help them at night.

Registration

Once I register what happens next?

Once the deposit payment or full payment has been made (must be within 12 hours) to confirm/hold your spots, you will receive an email confirmation, to the email attached to your family file. If you do not receive the email, please check your spam/junk folder. Please ensure the email address we have on file is correct.

The week before camp begins you will receive an email with that weeks information.

FAQ'S

Camp Staff

What is the age of your staff?

Senior Staff - 17-26 years of age + up

Junior Staff - 15 or 16 years old

What is the ratio of supervision?

Our counsellor to camper ratio is 1:8 for finished JK-Grade3 and 1:10 for finished Grade 4 and up.

Safety

What happens if it rains?

When at Kelso, camp groups will seek shelter under one of the many covered picnic pavilions, or at one of the buildings we may have access too. We cannot guarantee though that your child will not get wet.

For our King's location, campers can seek shelter indoors at the facility.

What happens if there is a heat advisory in effect?

We cannot control the weather but we do monitor the weather warnings closely and implement a modified program when necessary. This includes reduced physical activity and increased water breaks throughout the day when a heat advisory is in effect.

Staff will schedule regular sunscreen breaks throughout the day and ensure campers re-apply their sunscreen at least every 3 hours while at camp (staff assist younger campers to do so, while older campers will apply their own/buddy up with a friend to do so).

**Parents should be sure to apply sunscreen on their child before dropping them off at camp/the bus.

What happens if my child becomes sick or injured at camp?

All of our staff are CPR and First Aid Certified and are trained to address routine illness or injuries (upset tummy, headaches, scraped knee etc.) Parents will be notified if the Camp Director feels it is necessary for the camper to be picked up early due to his/her illness or injury. In the event of a more serious injury or illness, telephone service is readily available to call 911. Vehicles are also on site to transport a child to a nearby health care center if our Director feels they should be looked at by a doctor.
